



## SHOTTESBROOKE SPARKLING

### BLANC DE BLANC NV

*(The whitest white - Sparkling white wine made from Chardonnay grapes)*

Shottesbrooke is a small exclusive family owned vineyard and winery set in the eastern pocket of the beautiful and tranquil McLaren Vale, just 45 minutes from Adelaide. Magnificent views over the gum-studded vineyards, up to the rolling Willunga Hills, can be viewed from the award winning cellar door opened in April 1995.

Shottesbrooke winery takes its name from Shottesbrooke Park in Berkshire, England. This label depicts the parish church built in 1337 and is a fine example of Decorated Period architecture.

#### Tasting Notes

##### Colour

Pale straw with a slight green tinge and a fine persistent bead.

##### Nose

Classic Blanc de Blanc nose that displays white chocolate and vanilla notes with traces of almond and citrus.

##### Palate

A sophisticated palate that shows a beautifully defined sparkling wine with intense, lingering flavours of lime, lemon and freshly baked bread.

**Food Match** Perfectly served as an aperitif, with char-grilled Australian seafood or after a meal as a palate cleanser.
