



94 Points, 2006 Shottesbrooke *Eliza Shiraz*

A consistent performer, the Eliza has scored 94 points for the 2004, 2005 and now the 2006 vintage.



5 Glasses (94+) – Outstanding. Wine of the highest quality, usually with a distinguished pedigree.

In typical Shottesbrooke fashion, offers an alternative but utterly delicious expression of McLaren Vale fruit, with lively, spicy fruit, daubs of chocolate and licorice running through the long and vibrant palate. Drink to 2018



93 Points, 2007 Shottesbrooke Cabernet Sauvignon



4 ½ glasses (90-93) – Highly recommended. Wine of great quality, style and character, worthy of a place in any cellar. Deep crimson; pure varietal blackcurrant fruit drives the bouquet and palate; there are some of the dusty tannin of the merlot, but here the volume of the fruit sustains them. Good value. Drink to 2020

93 Points, 2006 Shottesbrooke *Punch Cabernet Sauvignon*



4 ½ glasses (90-93) – Highly recommended. Wine of great quality, style and character, worthy of a place in any cellar. Has very good varietal definition to both varietal and palate; black fruit with a dusting of dark chocolate runs through an even palate with excellent line and balance. Drink to 2016

91 Points, 2007 Shottesbrooke Shiraz



4 ½ glasses (90-93) – Highly recommended. Wine of great quality, style and character, worthy of a place in any cellar. In the elegant, medium bodied frame that is the Shottesbrooke style; black fruits, bitter chocolate and dashes of spice and licorice on the finish – even in this vintage. Drink to 2015
